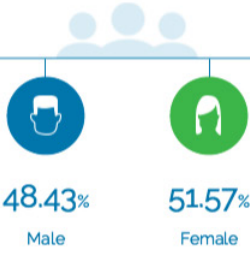

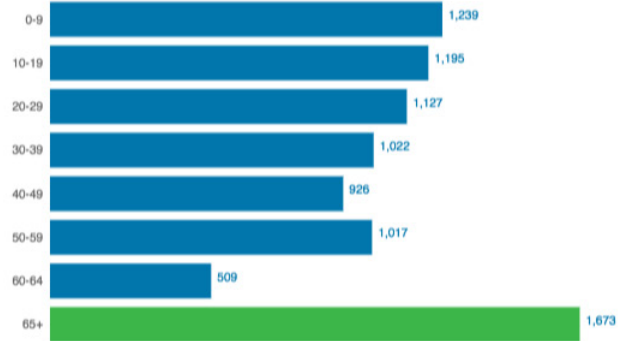
The total population of Graham is 8,707. The median age is 36.7

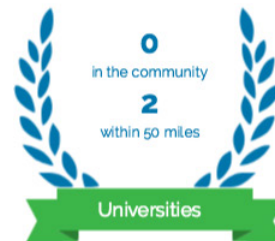

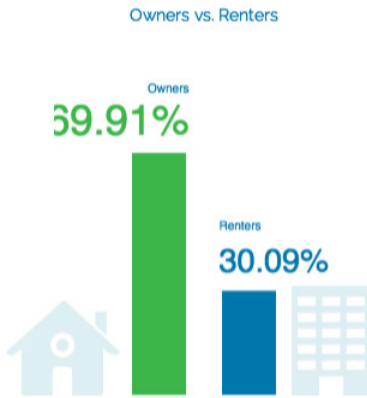

There are 132% more households who own their homes than there are renters.



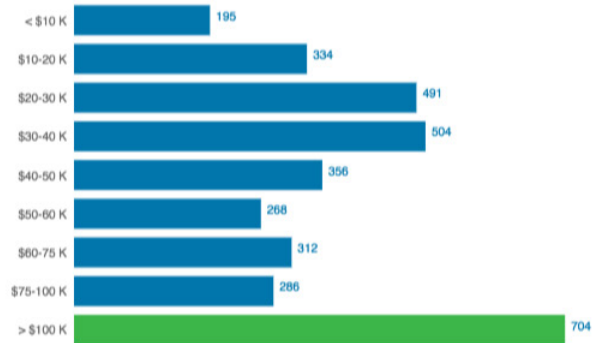
Income and Spending

Income Distribution



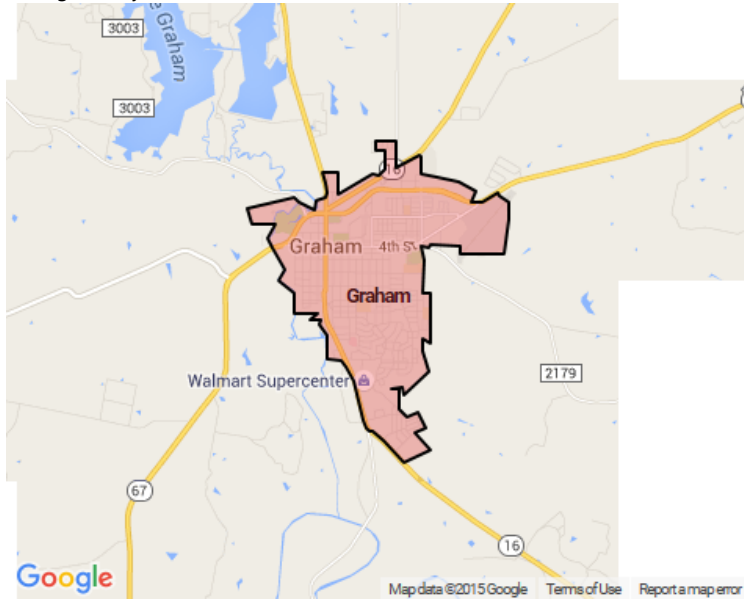
How do people spend most of their money?
